3. A Letter of Acceptance from the post-secondary school of their choice must be postmarked no later than May 15th.
4. All applications must be completely filled in and must be accompanied by the following attachments:
 - a. Sealed copy of applicant's complete academic record and standardized test scores to date.
 - b. Minimum three (3) different references. (*Examples: School Counselor, Teacher, Clergy, etc.*)
 - c. Letter of Acceptance from the post-secondary school of their choice

The Order Sons of Italy, Annapolis Lodge #2225 has established an educational scholarship to primarily assist current eligible high school graduates or current students, and secondarily assist current students enrolled at a post-secondary school in continuing their education in an accredited post-secondary institution of their choice.

Up to three (3) Scholarship non-renewable grants will be awarded in an amount not less than \$1,000.00.

- ❖ Applicant must be Italian or of Italian Descent.

- ❖ Applicant must be a son/daughter or grandson/granddaughter of a current member of the Annapolis Lodge #2225 who has been in good standing for one year prior to application.
 - *Good standing defined as: Member with current paid dues*
 - *Member(s) defined as: Parent (mother/father/both); legal guardian, grandparent(s).*
